



Communicate Clearly: Ask Clarifying Questions

Asking clarifying questions is designed to help avoid uncertain situations. Ask clarifying questions when you need to better understand what is going on. Studies show the probability of making a wrong assumption is reduced 2.5 times when you ask one or two clarifying questions.¹

We are committed to creating an environment where it is always safe for anyone to ask questions. Make it easy for others to speak up by using these safety phrases:

- "Let me ask a clarifying question..."
- · "Do you have any clarifying questions?"

Clarifying questions can be asked:

- In high-risk situations.
- If information is incomplete or ambiguous.
- When you are unsure.

Services provided include:

- Eye Exam (covered by Parkland's vision plan)
- Selection of glasses and eyewear for employees covered by Parkland's vision plan and available to employees with a valid, outside prescription.
- Contact lens exams for existing wearers only.
