## Second part of Annual Required Training is now available

Part two of Parkland's Annual Required Training is now live! This training is essential for meeting compliance and ethics, information security and regulatory requirements. Annual, mandatory training is crucial to Parkland fulfilling our mission for Dallas County. All annual training modules are now available in Parkland Pathways and must be completed by Wednesday, Aug. 20.

### NEW: There will be no grace period after the Aug. 20 deadline this year

### How can I access this training?

Employees can access the training by taking the following steps.

- 1. Using your Parkland network ID\* and password, log in to Parkland Pathways by clicking <u>here</u>. You can also access Parkland Pathways from the Parkland Intranet Home page.
- 2. Under "My Learning Assignments," locate the Annual Required Training 2025 Phase II program. Make sure to also complete the Phase I program if you haven't already done so.
- 3. Click on the assignment to view and launch the training program.

All annual training will be assigned in Parkland Pathways and must be completed by Wednesday, Aug. 20. Be sure to log into Parkland Pathways to complete this training!

\*As a reminder, your network log-in credentials are the same as you use to log-in to a Parkland computer or Epic.

### **How to Participate:**

- 1. Ensure you've set up your profile at myCigna.com or in the myCigna app. Select Wellness from the home screen, then click Wellness Dashboard under Wellness Home and fill out a brief form to set up your Wellness Experience profile.
- 2. From the Wellness Home, select Challenges from the menu and complete registration, adding up to five people per team. You may also participate in the challenge solo, but you'll boost your step score with more people on a team.
- 3. Get credit for your steps! Integrate with Apple Health or other fitness tracking devices to easily track your daily steps. In the myCigna app, go to the Wellness Home, select Resources (far right option in the top menu bar) > Devices and Apps > Connect with Apple Health OR Connect a Device
- 4. Be sure you're logging in regularly to get credit for tracked steps. You may get credit for up to 30K steps per day. If you finish early, keep stepping or another team may pass you! All steps must be uploaded by August 22 at 11:59 p.m. CST.

## REMINDER: Custom T-shirts are no longer approved

We've seen a rise in requests for custom department T-shirts and other branded apparel—so it's a good time to remind everyone that Parkland updated its apparel guidelines last year.

To protect our brand and keep things consistent across the organization, all department apparel orders must now go through the Gift Shop and follow the official design standards. That means:

- No more custom or one-off department designs.
- Approved apparel can feature the Parkland logo with your department name underneath—nothing more.
- Marketing will only create and approve specialty designs that are pertinent to an entire division or systemwide special occasion (CelebrateUs!, ICARE, etc. )

Rather than having to schedule an appointment with an offsite optometrist or eye care professional, Parkland will host OnSight Eyes on campus from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Tuesday, July 15, through Thursday, July 17 for employees currently enrolled in Parkland's vision plan. ### Services provided include:

- Eye Exam (covered by Parkland's vision plan)
- Selection of glasses and eyewear for employees covered by Parkland's vision plan.
